

<u>BYOD</u>

Reading Fluency

Fluent reading leads to better comprehension. Encourage your child to read and reread familiar stories. Pay attention to punctuation, listen for inflection in their voice, and ask questions after reading to check for understanding. Read aloud and model what a good reader sounds like. This will help your child to practice reading more fluently.

Multiplication Tips

2 x 4 = 8 factor x factor = product

- First factor----Number of groups
- Second factor--Amount in each group
- Product--total (not the answer)
- 2 x 4 is the same as 2 groups of 4 (2 groups with 4 in each group)
- 4 + 4 (repeated addition)
- When working with arrays, First Factor----Number of rows Second Factor--Number of columns
- Product-----Total amount in the array
