Curriculum

<u>Reading</u>

 Students will distinguish their own point of view from that of the narrator or characters.

<u>Writing</u>

• Students will start to research carnivorous plants to begin the next information research paper.

<u>Math</u>

 Students will understand the parts of a fraction and explore a fraction as a number on the number line.

<u>Science</u>

 Students will discuss the function of plant structures (roots, stem, leaves, flowers) as it relates to the survival of plants in their environment and explain how environmental conditions determine how well plants survive and grow.



Starting this week, students will have Math EOG practice for homework. They will receive review problems daily that should be solved each night and returned to school the next day. Since the math will be reviewed daily, it's important for each student to bring back the practice activity for review.
